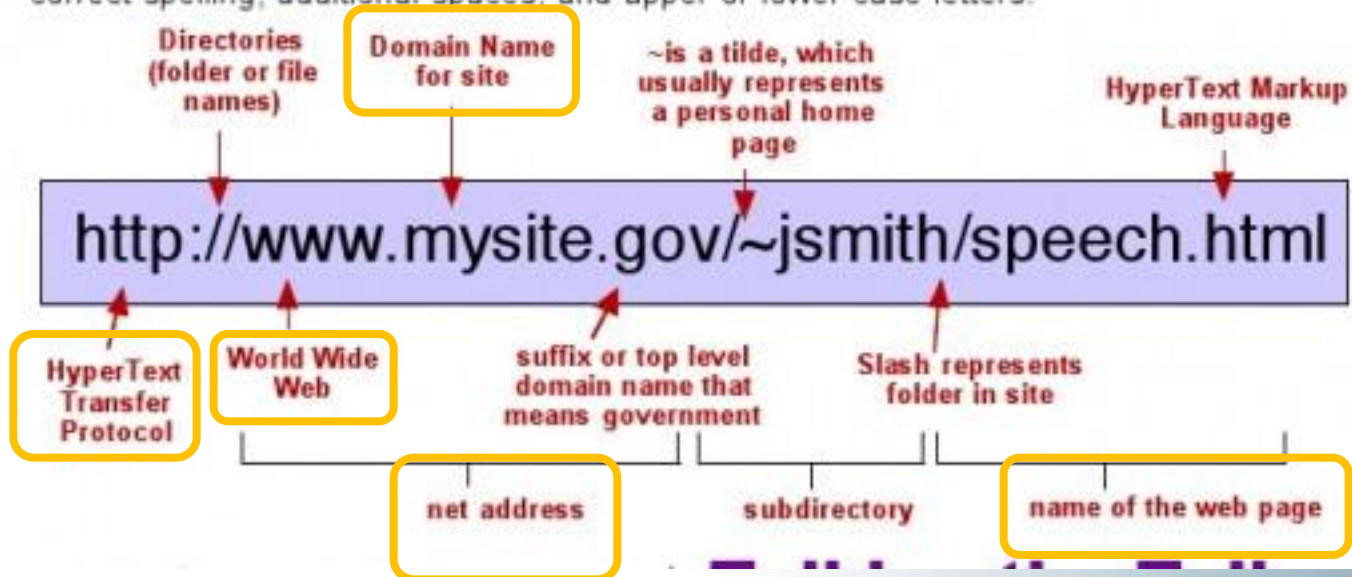
Anatomy of a URL

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Uniform Resource Locator

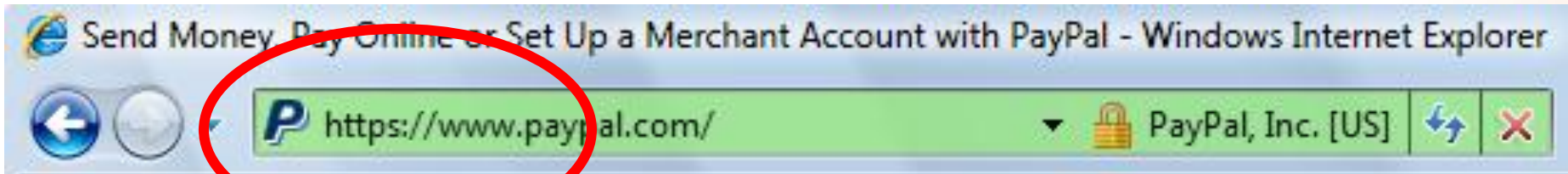

Uniform Resource Locator is the address you type in, bookmark, or click on to get to a place on the Internet. This is similar to your home address and is where a page or site resides on the World Wide Web. Unfortunately, people sometimes move their pages or change their email address without letting you know. It is just like someone moving and not giving you a forwarding address. URLs are sensitive to correct spelling, additional spaces, and upper or lower case letters.

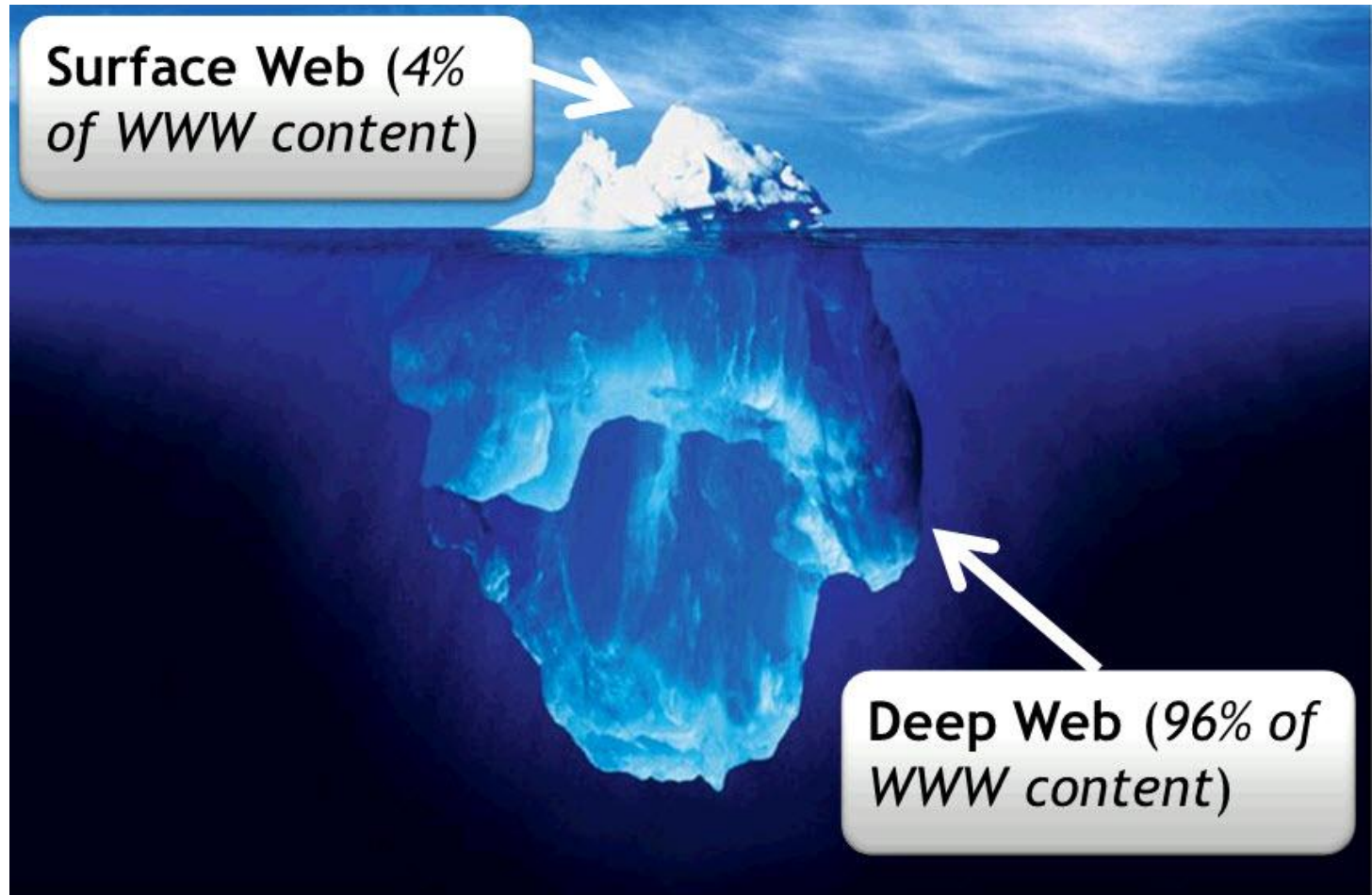

Phishing

When internet fraudsters impersonate a business to trick you into giving out your personal information, it's called phishing. Don't reply to email, text, or pop-up messages that ask for your personal or financial information. Don't click on links within them either — even if the message seems to be from an organization you trust. It isn't. Legitimate businesses don't ask you to send sensitive information through insecure channels.
